MESSAGE FROM GOVERNING COUNCIL CHAIRMAN

What Do I Get If I Join FGBMFI?

The question of what one gets when one joins the FGBMFI was brought up at the last Board Meeting. Many members were still not clear of the main objective of their membership. Since I was with the first National President, Dr. Peter Tong, at the inception of the FGBMFI, perhaps I can enlighten potential members and even existing members a little about it. Anyone joining an organisation, association or even a club would like to know what to expect. I will give a few key privileges which I think will help in giving a clearer picture of the purpose of joining the FGBMFI.

First, is the privilege of serving JESUS. At our regular chapter meetings, the 'Mission Statement' which we recite is the very purpose of our Fellowship. It spells out everything we are supposed to do in our service to JESUS. That was the vision given to our founder President, Demos Shakarian, who subsequently incorporated the FGBMFI on 2 January, 1953. The book 'The Happiest People on Earth' spells out the history and progress of the FGBMFI. This book should have been read by all members and given to prospective members.

In the beginning, you will attend chapter meetings and then invite friends to 'banquets.' You will encourage new believers to be filled with the Holy Spirit and help them grow spiritually. You will be encouraged to be a strong witness for JESUS while maintaining a strong fellowship and unity in the body of Christ. As you mature, you will be invited to go on 'airlifts' to other cities and even to other nations. Your perspective of what God is doing through the FGBMFI will be widened. as your relationship with God be deepened.

The next privilege is more personal – to know JESUS better. You will meet with more mature believers whom the LORD may use to help you or mentor you to grow spiritually. In serving JESUS, your relationship with God will be deepened for that closer walk with Him. This will greatly help to maintain your passion and commitment in serving Him. The key is that you will be challenged to read and live the Word of God daily. In the beginning this would seem like a daunting task but once you get into the habit, with the help of the Holy Spirit, it will be a very enlightening experience. My close relationship and walk with the Lord was made possible by the encouragement I received from my three mentors, namely, Dr. Peter Tong, Bro. Timothy Phua and Bro. Ang Chui Lai.

The level of maturity to be desired is to be more like JESUS. This privilege is a lifetime journey in the

company of similar minded men. It is iron sharpening iron on a regular basis. The things of the world will grow more and more dim as we behold more and more of the Glory of the God. The prompting will be to surrender completely to Him in order to be more like Him. The journey may not be smooth all the time. There will be hiccups along the way, but being in JESUS, we will be more than conquerors. Many a time there will be the desire to quit when things do not go our way but experiencing and the hand of the Lord in every situation will be reassuring. I learned to trust Him more and more with the confidence that I will never be put to shame.

Lastly, is the privilege to give to JESUS your talents, finances and your will. Trusting in the Lord completely will be the most exciting hurdle to overcome. All the challenging events that we have experienced that would enable us to see the things ahead more clearly. All talents are gifts from Him before our parents conceived us. Along the way we would have messed up in the way we lived. That is the reason He assures us that the battle belongs to Him. The finances He placed in our hands are for us to use what we need and the rest to let Him direct us according to His will. It is greatly for our benefit as it is for the Kingdom to allow JESUS to be in control.

As I surrender control to JESUS, I live in the love, joy and peace that He places in my heart. I find that the best deal I had made in my life was to join the FGBMFI. 1 Corinthians 9:24 Do you not know that in a race all the runners run, but only one gets the prize? Run in such a way as to get the prize.

加入FGBMFI，会有什么得着呢？

“加入FGBMFI会有什么得着？”最近有人在全国董事部会议中提出这个问题。许多会员不太清楚自己取得会员籍可达到什么主要目标。既然我早在马来西亚全备福音男士团契（FGBMFI）成立时，就已与第一任全国总会长Dr. Peter Tong 在一起，或许我可稍作分享来启发潜在会员，甚至现有会员。任何人加入某个团体、协会甚至俱乐部，都想知道可得着什么。在此列出几项主要特权，相信有助大家更清楚加入FGBMFI的目标。

首先是有特权来服事耶稣。在例常分会会议上，大家背诵的“使命宣言”就有提到让基督徒有机会聚在一起团契。这表示我们所做的一切都是为了服事耶稣。这正是创办人狄摩士弟兄(Demos Shakarian)的异象，他随后在 1953年1月2日成立 FGBMFI。《世界上最快乐的人》这本书也叙述了 FGBMFI 的历史与演变。所有会员都应阅读这本著作并送给潜在会员。

开始时你先自己出席分会会议，接着邀请朋友参与“餐会”。你会鼓励初信者领受圣灵充满，并帮助他们的灵性成长。你受激励大力为主耶稣作见证，并与基督肢体保持紧密的团契与合一。当你灵命足够成熟，将受邀请前往其他城市甚至其他国家“分享见证”(airlifts)来传福音。随着你与上帝的关系日益密切，对于上帝在FGBMFI所做的事情，你会有日渐广阔视野。

另一个特权则比较在个人层面——更加认识主耶稣。你会认识更多灵性成熟的基督徒，而上帝会使用他们来帮助你

或督导你的灵性成长。在服事主耶稣的过程，你与主同行，与上帝更亲近。这可帮助你持续火热并委身服事主。关键就在于你要受激励每天都读经，并活出圣经教导。开始时，这会是让人畏惧却步的任务，一旦养成习惯，加上圣灵帮助，就成了启迪人心的体验。我之所以能够与主同行，紧紧跟随主，是受到三位督导师：Dr. Peter Tong, Timothy Phua 弟兄与 Ang Chui Lai 弟兄的鼓励。

渴望要达到的灵性成熟度应该是活像主耶稣。在 FGBMFI 可享有的特权就是会认识理念相同的属灵同伴。大家常常在一起互相切磋，如铁磨铁越磨越利。随着我们更多注视主的荣耀，来自世界的影响力会渐渐地衰微。要活像主耶稣就要全人降服，将生命主权交给祂。这样的人生历程并不一定会一帆风顺。间中会有些挫折，然而，在主里面我们必能得胜。当事情不如意时，会让人想放弃，当个逃兵，然而主的恩手始终不离不弃，一路牵引着我们前行。我学习信靠祂，益发坚定信心，相信我不至于蒙羞愧。

最后一个的特权就是将你的恩赐才干、财富与意志献上给主耶稣。要做到完全信靠主，是最难跨越的关卡。一切的挑战会让我们更看清楚未来。我们还未出世时，主已赐下一切恩赐才干。在人生旅程中，我们可能会搞砸一些事情。这就是为什么祂向我们保证祂已争战得胜。祂放在我们手中的财富是要供应我们的需要，其余的就要按着祂的旨意来使用。这是为了神的国度，让主耶稣掌权，可让我们得着最大的好处。

当我降服在主耶稣手中，就活出充满爱、喜乐平安的生命。我发现选择加入FGBMFI真是明智之举。哥林多前书九章24节（当代译本CCB）：“你们知道吗？在运动场上赛跑的人虽然个个都在跑，但冠军只有一个。同样，你们也要努力奔跑，好获得奖赏。”

YB. DATUK LIEW VUI KIONG

The date 2nd October 2020 marked a sad day for the FGB Sabah Region as well as FGBMFI Malaysia. It was the fateful day where our very dear brother YB. Datuk Liew Vui Kiong went home to be with the LORD. To his close friends and brothers in Christ he was affectionately known by his moniker VK Liew.

He was an illustrious FGB member in the Government Mountain where he once served as Minister of Law in the Federal Government of Malaysia. It was under Datuk VK Liew's watch the Emergency Ordinance 1969 was lifted and the Internal Security Act (ISA) was repealed in November 2011. VK Liew was a strong advocate for the total abolition of death penalty in Malaysia. Due to the strong objections by certain quarters the death penalty is no longer mandatory even though the death penalty law was not repealed.

Bro VK Liew became a born-again Christian through the FGB KK Chapter where he was a member and had attended the meetings regularly between 2005 to 2008. He facilitated in setting up the FGB Kota Belud Chapter in 2006 and had helped to organize many of its evangelistic banquet events. Bro VK Liew was unashamed of his faith in the LORD and always ready to share his testimonies glorifying the name of our Lord Jesus Christ. He had spoken in many FGB organized functions across Malaysia.

His soul now rests in eternal peace in the heavenly abode.



BRO ROBIN ZHANG

Bro Robin Zhang joined the FGBMFI Vietnam in 2002 and was one of the first core team members and a board member. He had been leading the development of the Chinese speaking chapter there.

Bro Robin Zhang became the third National President of FGBMFI Vietnam in 2009. He had attended the FGBMFI Asian conferences in Malaysia, Taiwan and Singapore, and actively participated in the promotion of the FGBMFI ministry in Vietnam.

After undergoing a coronary heart bypass surgery in 2012 in Malaysia, he ceased his role as the National President of FGBMFI Vietnam. However, Brother Robin Zhang still actively participated in FGBMFI's ministry and church work.

Brother Robin Zhang was called by the Lord due to a heart attack on February 25, 2020, and his soul now rests in the arms of the Heavenly Father.



FGBMFI FOOD AID PROGRAMME

Report on FGBMFI Food Aid Programme in Central Region from 28 March 2020 until 9 June 2020.

When the Government executed the Movement Control Order (MCO) on 18 March, 2020, it required the closure of all businesses except those providing essential services and items. Consequently, there arose an urgent need for food aid and the FGBMFI Food Aid Programme was launched on 28 March 2020. The initiative was a consensus between the FGB Central Regional Director and National President.

The food relief project was coordinated by a team led by the Central Region Deputy Regional Director (Kuala Lumpur City Centre Zone). The programme ran from 28 March till 9 June 2020.

One hundred and twelve donors contributed a total sum of RM105,651. The collection was fully disbursed in kind. A total of 14,575 packs of prepared food, 1,009 packs of food provisions - rice, eggs, cooking oil, flour and rice noodles (mee hoon) and 1,400 packs of NZ milk powder were distributed.

5. Pudu, Cheras (Old folks' home).
6. Jalan Ipoh, Kuang (Migrant workers)
7. Lahad Datu, Sabah (Stateless Bajau Gypsy community)
8. Taman Wahyu, Kg Sg Kayu Ara (Vulnerable communities)

We wish to record our sincere thanks to all contributors and the FGB brothers for their teamwork, care and love towards feeding the poor and needy during the Covid-19 MCO period.

FGBMFI FOOD DISTRIBUTION PROGRAMME IN JOHOR BAHRU FGBMFI在新山分派米粮的善举

The idea of the programme was actually birthed during a conversation between the FGB National President, Bro HH Fong and the Southern Region Director, Bro Samuel Tan in late March. Although it was initially meant for East Malaysians and migrants, it was extended to West Malaysians including the Orang Asli and other migrant groups.

How the Lord moved and drew in the contributors was nothing short of a miracle. More than 100 people contributed in terms of cash. They were requested to bank-in to a personal account, not to an NGO or even the FGB account. The only question asked by some was "Who is Ricky Lim Beng Teck?". Of course, he is our FGBMFI treasurer. They donated with a trusting heart.

God linked us to four churches to anchor the programme. The churches are the Full Gospel Church, Calvary City Church, Church of Praise and Permas Jaya Baptist Church. The Fellowship is currently networking with about 27 churches. Most of them are Iban or Bahasa Malaysia-speaking churches.

God also connected us to a large company (known here as KB Group) and the Ponderosa Golf and Country Club which started contributing food packs. Since 2 April, 2020, more than 12,000 food packs were received. As the needs were bigger than envisaged, the KB Group began providing grocery boxes. By the end of May, more than 5,600 boxes were received and distributed. Praise the Lord!

The contributions, both in cash and kind including the grocery boxes would have totalled RM500,000. Isn't this a miracle? An estimated 2,500 individuals and families had been blessed through the programme.

From the beginning it was agreed that 100% of the funds collected would be utilised and distributed. The final accounts will be sent to CS Tan & Co for an independent audit.

Isaiah 58:6-12 was the guiding scriptures stating God's requirement on true fasting and its promises of blessings. The prayers of the members truly moved the Hands of God in ensuring the success of the food programme.

此项善举的构思，是马来西亚男士福音团契（FGB）全国总会长方鸿兴弟兄（HH Fong）三月杪与南部区域会长陈徽清弟兄（Samuel Tan）聊天时无意间提起的。这个计划原本只是要惠及东马与移工，但扩大至西马，包括原住民与其他移工群体。

上帝如何感动乐捐者的心，本身就是个神迹。超过100名善心人士捐献现金。他们受促将捐款汇入个人账户，而不是非政府组织（NGO）或FGB账户。只有有些人会问一下：“谁是Ricky Lim Beng Teck？”当然，他正是FGBMFI财政。大家都出于信任而乐捐。

上帝带领我们与四间教会连结来共襄善举。这四间教会分别是全备福音教会（Full Gospel Church）、加略山城市教会（Calvary City Church）、赞美教会（Church of Praise）与百万镇浸信教会（Permas Jaya Baptist Church）。本团契目前约与27间教会有联系。大部分是伊班语或马来语教会。

上帝也带领我们联系上某大公司（在此称为KB集团），而黄松高尔夫球俱乐部（Ponderosa Golf and Country Club）亦开始捐献粮包。从2020年4月2日起，收到超过1万2000个粮包。由于需求比想象中更大，KB集团开始供应米粮杂货盒。到了5月杪，收到超过5600盒并分派给有需要者。赞美主！

有关捐献，包括现金与米粮杂货盒等恩物，总值超过50万令吉。难道这不是神迹吗！估计有2500个人与家庭从这项善举中受惠。

打从一开始就说好了要将100%的资金完全善用并分派出去。最终账目将交由CS Tan & Co进行独立审计。

以赛亚书五十八章6-12节是引导我们的经文，陈明上帝所拣选的禁食与祂所应许的祝福。众会员的祷告确实摇动全能上帝的手，看顾这项分派米粮善举顺利完成。

The Central Region AMC 2020 had its meeting on 10 October, 2020 via Zoom. The meeting was attended by 155 members.

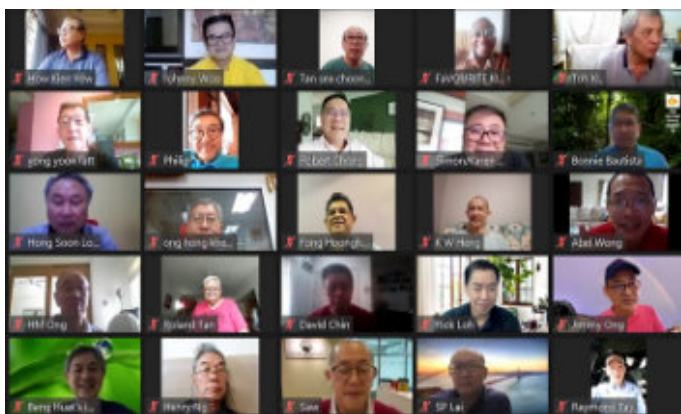
The meeting began with a welcome address by Bro. Davie Samuel. It was followed by an opening prayer by Bro. Stanley Tan and an inspiring praise and worship led by Bro. Yesudas.

The National Secretary Bro. Henry Wong and the National Treasurer, Bro. Chee Yon Long then presented their respective reports. Bro. Richard Ling, a Governing Council member, delivered a challenging and blessed message on 'Why Give?'

In conjunction with the 2020 AMC theme 'Fulfilling our Apostolic Calling', the National President, Bro HH Fong, addressed the members with a 3-G message based on i) Gospel-Centred ii) Geographical Extended and iii) Generational Impacted.

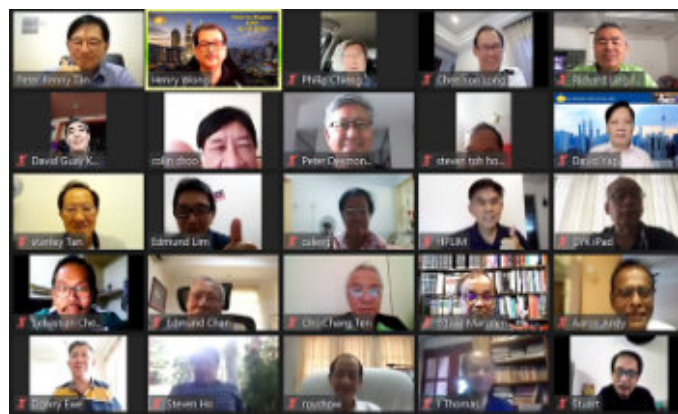

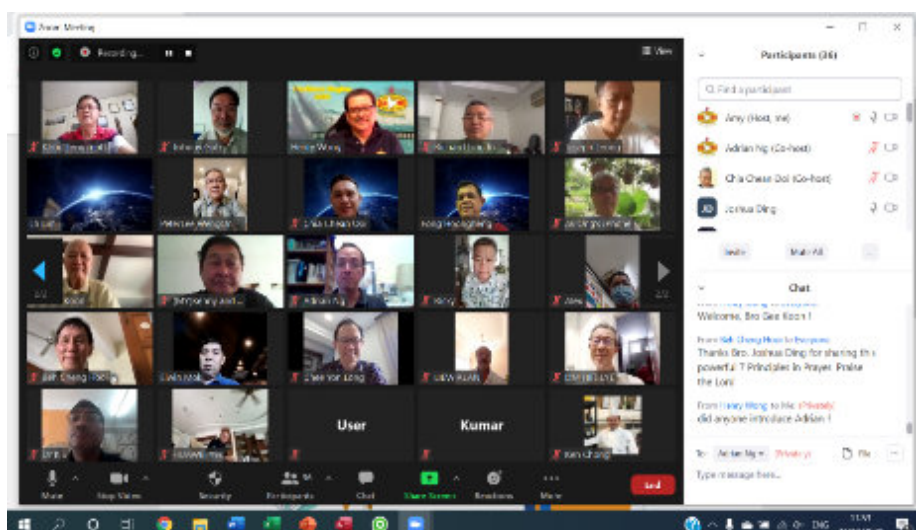
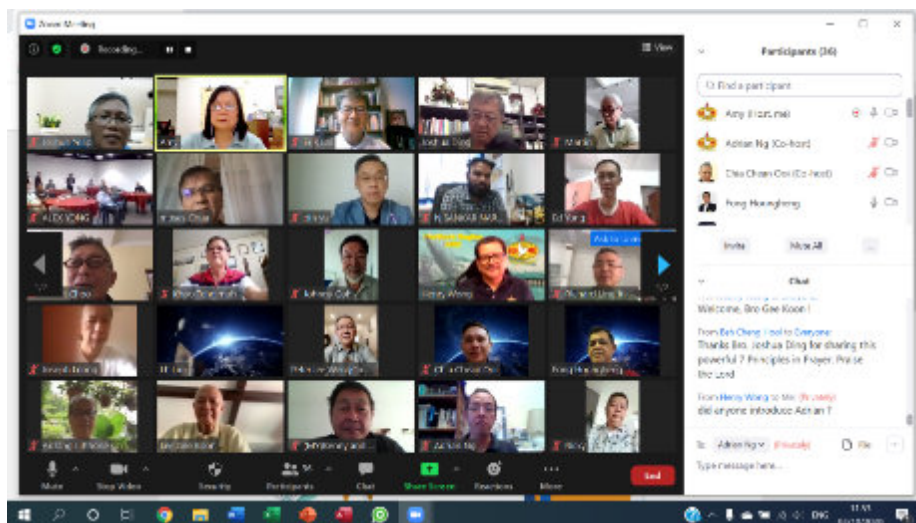
Living the Abundant Life, Leaving a Legacy

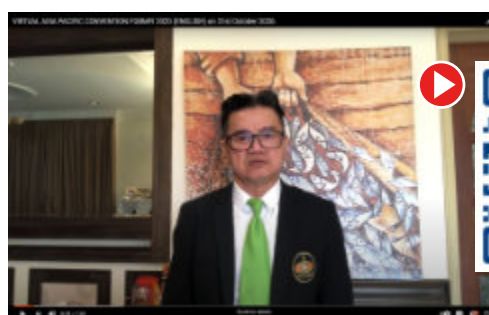

BASIC ZOOM ETIQUETTE

使用Zoom视频会议的基本礼仪

• Mute your microphone

To help keep background noise to a minimum, make sure you mute your microphone when you are not speaking.

• Be mindful of background noise

When your microphone is not muted, avoid activities that could create additional noise, such as shuffling papers, adjusting the microphone jack, noisy fans etc.

• Position your camera properly

If you choose to use a web camera, be sure it is in a stable position and focused at eye level, if possible. Doing so helps create a more direct sense of engagement with other participants. If you are using the built-in camera in your pc, adjust it so that it is focussed at eye level.

• Limit distractions

You can make it easier to focus on the meeting by turning off notifications, closing or minimizing running apps, and muting your smartphone.

• Avoid multi-tasking

You'll retain the discussions better if you refrain from replying to emails or texting messages and wait to work on that PowerPoint presentation until after the meeting ends.

• Prepare materials in advance

If you are sharing content, make sure you have the files and/or links ready to go before the meeting begins.

• Keep your video mode on

It is considered rude to continually display your profile picture

• **Ensure your name is displayed** and not the default e.g. GalaxyS9 or Jane's dad.

The FGB Sabah Zoom meetings were born out of necessity attributable to the Covid-19 pandemic. The Zoom application then appeared the most appropriate due to its ease of use and file sharing capabilities. Initially, we grappled with the issue of security and the willingness of our FGB brothers to learn new skills. After getting the approval from our Regional Director, Dr. David Fung, we initiated our maiden Zoom chapter meeting on 31st March 2020.

To date, we have organised a total of twenty-five meetings. Among our list of invited speakers were bankers, think tank consultants, business consultants, corporate business leaders, a Deputy Chief Minister cum Minister of Trade, GLC Chairman, an intellectual property lawyer and pastors.

The Movement Control order had only opened up our FGBMFI meetings via Zoom to operate on a global scale. Now our speakers and audiences could be from anywhere around the world, further uniting the body of Christ. Halleluiah! Praise the Lord!

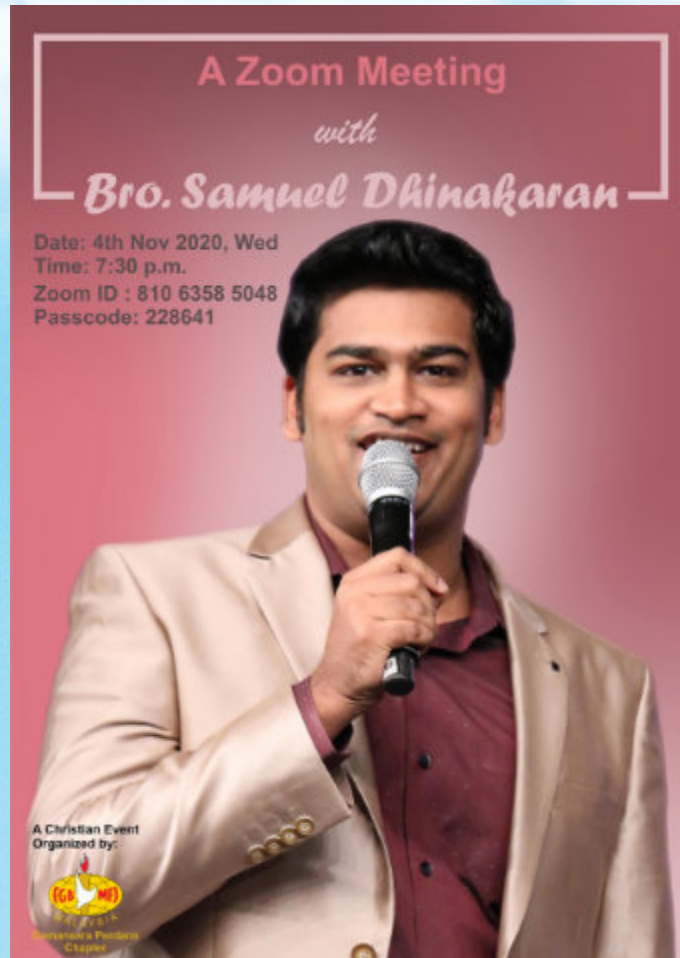
They have 12 prayer towers globally, touching millions of people. There is one prayer tower in PJ where someone will pray with you when you call 03-7960 7370.

THE ELIJAH CHALLENGE

以利亚的挑战事工

Pastor William Lau is the founder of The Elijah Challenge and the Lord has used him to teach many on the subject of healing. The approach has been proven effective and instrumental in helping the Church to fulfil the Great Commission. John 14:12 Very truly I tell you, whoever believes in me will do the works I have been doing, and they will do even greater things than these, because I am going to the Father.

The Elijah Challenge trains harvest workers to reach resistant people groups effectively and fruitfully by training them to heal the sick miraculously as Jesus did (John 14:11-12)—as irrefutable and compelling evidence that Jesus is the Messiah and the only way to the One True God who created the heavens and the earth.

Two years ago, Pr. William visited Malaysia to train some of the FGBMFI brothers to minister and heal in the mighty name of Jesus. This month, he shared with us on two evenings on the 10th & 11th of December 2020 via zoom.

We had about three hundred and twenty-five participants on the first evening and four hundred and thirty-five on the second. Many instant healings happened! Many were amazed - knowing and learning about the mountain-moving faith to heal the sick.

Pr. William categorized and taught about three primary offices – Priest, Prophet and King.

He urged us to operate with Kingly authority as illustrated in Luke 4:31 Then He went down to Capernaum, a city of Galilee, and was teaching them on the Sabbath. v32 And they were astonished at His teaching, for His word was with AUTHORITY.

Luke 4:35 further demonstrates the action of AUTHORITY Jesus took in the synagogue when the demon reared its ugly head while He was teaching. Jesus rebuked him, saying, "Be quiet, and come out of him!" The key concept in the Elijah Challenge was AUTHORITY.

Testimonies and biblical stories were used as examples of how Jesus healed - Jesus did not pray to His Father to heal, but simply commanded the sicknesses and diseases to leave at once! Nothing is impossible when we believe. We felt truly empowered to be a part of The Kingdom of God!

路加福音四章35节进一步说明耶稣在会堂行使权柄的举动，当时耶稣在会堂教导，有个被污鬼附身的人高声喊叫，耶稣责备它说：“住口！从他身上出来！”以利亚的挑战事工，核心概念就是行使权柄。

在分享会上，讲员通过见证与圣经故事作为范例，来说明耶稣如何行使医治大能—耶稣并没有祷告祈求天父医治病人，而是直接命令疾病退去！只要相信，凡事都有可能。我们深深地感受到神大能的托付，以成为神国度的一分子！

SPECIAL FEATURE ON SiEC 介绍 SiEC 的特别专题

The Sabah Interdenominational Education Committee (SiEC) is a Functional Committee birthed by the Sabah Council of Churches (SCC) and Commission of Sabah Affairs (COSA) in June 2016 to focus on the education sector.

Mission of the SiEC:

1. To identify strategies to raise the educational standards of Christian communities in Sabah, both rural and urban;
2. To mobilize Christian communities and partners to be involved in educational development with a shared vision for a better future for our children; and
3. To strengthen the faith of the next generation through Schools Ministry and Christian Education.

For the first three years, SiEC functioned as a Coordinating Body to promote collaboration and synergy among the various entities involved in schools and education, like the Sabah Council of Christian Mission Schools, the Sabah Mission Kindergartens Committee, the Schools Ministry Committee, Campus Ministry Network and Restorative Education Empowerment Programme. The key partners of the Schools Ministry Committee are Scripture Union, Persekutuan Guru-Guru Kristian Sabah, Campus Crusade for Christ and Full Gospel Business Men's Fellowship Malaysia.

On 6 April 2019, SiEC collaborated with the Sabah Ministry of Education and Innovation to host the 5th Sabah Education Roundtable. The meeting was held at the Federal Government Sabah Administrative Complex. SiEC presented Proposals for the Improvement of Educational Service and Impact in Sabah to YB Jenifer Lasimbang, Assistant Minister of Education and Innovation on behalf of the delegates at the end of the Roundtable.

沙巴跨宗派教育委员会（简称“SiEC”）是由沙巴基督教理事会（SCC）与基督教沙巴事务委员会（COSA）于2016年6月成立，专注于教育领域。

SiEC 的使命:

1. 鉴定提升沙巴乡区与城市基督教社群教育水准的策略；
2. 动员基督教社群与合作伙伴，在共同异象下参与教育发展，为我们的孩子缔造更美好未来；与
3. 通过学校事工与基督教教育来巩固下一代的信仰根基。

在首三年，SiEC扮演协调单位，促进涉及学校与教育各个团体之间的合作与协同效果，例如基督教宣教学校沙巴委员会（Sabah Council of Christian Mission Schools）、沙巴宣教幼儿园委员会（Sabah Mission Kindergartens Committee）、学校事工委员会（Schools Ministry Committee）、大专校园事工网络与复兴教育激励自主计划（Campus Ministry Network and Restorative Education Empowerment Programme）。学校事工委员会主要合作伙伴包括读经会（Scripture Union），沙巴基督教教师联合会（Persekutuan Guru-Guru Kristian Sabah），学园传道会（Campus Crusade for Christ）与马来西亚男士福音团契（Full Gospel Business Men's Fellowship Malaysia）。

在2019年4月6日，SiEC与沙巴教育及革新部合作举行第五届沙巴教育圆桌会议。此项会议在联邦政府沙巴行政大厦举行。SiEC在圆桌会议结束时，代表与会者向教育及革新部助理部长珍尼弗拉欣邦（YB Jenifer Lasimbang）呈交改进沙巴教育服务与效果的建议书。

The SiEC then launched a new initiative named **Project BASE** (Build, Advance, Strengthen, Empower) in all the districts. Using the Inter-Church Council platform and working together with ministry partners the priority needs of the respective districts were targeted. The mission was 'To Reach the Next Generation for Christ through Schools and Education.'

Project BASE used a Three-Track Approach:

1. Spiritual (Projek DamAI, Bible Knowledge and Christian Fellowship);
2. Social (Projek KNOW & Leaderonomics); and
3. Skillset (TVET & Career Guidance).

The SiEC's own home-grown programmes were Projek DamAI and Projek KNOW.

Projek DamAI was specifically designed to address the problem of shallow faith among the Christian children and teenagers. 'DamAI' is short for 'Dalami Asas Iman' (Deepening Spiritual Foundation). We have started training, both face-to-face and online, for our first series of books about 'First Things' as shown in the image.

SiEC自创计划是 DamAI项目与 KNOW项目。

DamAI 项目专门设计来解决基督徒孩子与青少年信心肤浅的问题。‘DamAI’的全称是‘Dalami Asas Iman’（灵命向下扎根）。我们开始使用下图所示的第一套系列丛书“第一件事”，通过实体与线上方式来培训。





SPECIAL FEATURE ON SiEC 介绍 SiEC的特别专题

In November 2020, an on-line survey to determine the spirituality of Christian youths in Sabah was launched. The preliminary findings of 1,130 respondents showed that many did not read the Bible regularly or evangelise to their friends. Nearly 28% did not know or were not confident of where they will go after death. Furthermore, only 34% of those youths attended church (online and on-site) regularly. The survey findings affirmed the mission of the SiEC to reach out to schools and educators to effectively disciple the next generation for Christ

Projek K.N.O.W. (Social Track)

Projek K.N.O.W. (Know Now, Opt for Wisdom) was designed to tackle the social issues that children and teenagers faced, such as: Social media and Gaming, Boy Girl Relationship, Mental Health, Culture and Faith. An online training about Social Media and Gaming Addiction was conducted with the teachers of St Patrick Anglican Academy, Tawau, on 9 and 16 October 2020. It was followed by separate sessions with their secondary and primary students on 13 and 17 November 2020 respectively (See screenshot below)

TVET Education Roadshow in Sabah 2021 (Skillset)

The SiEC will jointly organise the above roadshow with the National Economic Empowerment Coalition (NEEC) on 29 April to 2 May 2021 at four different locations in Sabah.

The objectives of the roadshow are:

1. To create awareness in parents on the importance of education for the community and future;
2. To reach out to SPM students regarding their future career;
3. To promote further education opportunities in TVET provided by higher education providers with consideration for spiritual formation.

With God, as Helper, and the support of SCC & COSA, the SiEC is confident that Project BASE and the Collaborative Network will impact the next generation for Christ to become a people 'who know their God and shall be strong and carry out great exploits for Him. (NKJV, Daniel 11:32).

在2020年11月，推展线上调查以确定沙巴基督徒青少年的灵命光景。1,130位受访者初步回应显示，许多人没有经常读圣经，也没有向朋友传福音。将近28%不知道或不肯定自己死后的归宿。此外，只有34%青少年忠心参与教会崇拜（线上与实体）。此调查结果确认SiEC肩负使命，接触学校与教育工作者，以有效地为基督训练新生代门徒。

K.N.O.W.项目(贴近社会脉搏)

K.N.O.W.项目(掌握时事, 智慧回应) 专门设计来追踪青少年在社会上面面对的社会课题，例如：社交媒体与线上游戏、男女关系，精神健康、文化与信仰。2020年10月9日及16日与斗湖St Patrick Anglican Academy 师生举行“社交媒体与线上游戏成瘾”的线上培训。随后于2020年11月13日与17日各别为其中学及小学生举办培训。（见以下截图）。

2021年沙巴技术和职业教育与培训（TVET）教育巡回说明会（技能）

The SiEC联合全国经济激励自主联盟（National Economic Empowerment Coalition, 简称“NEEC”）于2021年4月29日至5月2日在沙巴四个不同地点举行上述巡回说明会。

此巡回说明会的主要目标：

RECOVERY FROM A COMPLETE AND TOTAL DISASTER

The COVID-19 pandemic has caused all us to suffer some form of minor or major setbacks, unimaginable losses and even complete disasters in this perfect storm of unprecedented economic meltdown. Where can we turn for guidance and help?

The Bible in I Samuel 30 provides us with a model that had helped David recover all that he lost; and more than that. Our situation cannot be as disastrous as to what David faced.

Upon being delivered unexpectedly from a sticky situation of having to fight his own Hebrew brothers, David and his six hundred men were happily returning to Ziklag, when to their horror the Amalekites had raided, looted their base and taken all their families captive. They lost absolutely everything. They were devastated and traumatized. The men needed to put the blame on someone and David, their leader, was the natural target. Adding to his own complete loss, David faced the trauma of having his own men turn on him. What did David do?

1. **“But David strengthened himself in the Lord his God.”** (v6). In our distress we need to seek God first. But even before we do that, we must believe with absolute certainty who God is. He can and He will do all that is necessary to give us a way out of our difficulties. How do we strengthen ourselves? We recall His faithfulness in the past. His promises and His unfailing love in His Word. That He will never leave us or forsake us. Not only what we experienced ourselves but also from the testimonies of others.

2. Only after strengthening himself in the Lord, did **“David inquired of the Lord...”** (v8). There can be no options, no way out or there can also be too many options and we really have no clue which will work. We need to hear from Him. In David’s case, his dilemma was simply whether to pursue or not to pursue knowing full well that the Amalekites had a much larger fighting force than his six hundred men. Huge odds for him to contemplate. He needed the assurance from God that God will be with him in the battle and that God will deliver on His promise.

3. Now that he had the assurance from God, **“So David set out...”** (v9). He did not procrastinate. After hearing from God, he knew exactly what to do. He cast all doubts aside, not burdened by the numerical odds against him. Not concerned that his own men who wanted to kill him would not follow. He just acted upon the assurance from God. His men followed. If we are assured of who God is in our lives and do not doubt His promise, we will not waver, unsure whether we heard right from God. We just do it.

从大灾难中恢复

新冠肺炎 (Covid-19) 疫情或多或少都让人深感挫败与亏损, 甚至在空前经济严重衰退中已遭遇大难。我们要往何处寻求指引与帮助呢?

《圣经》在<撒母耳记上>三十章记载大卫如何从一切亏损中完全走出来。我们的情况绝对不会比大卫更悲惨。

在他不料中被免了出战希伯来同胞们, 大卫和600位战士高兴回到洗革拉。岂料亚玛力人已攻破侵夺洗革拉, 掳走了所有家眷。他们失去了一切! 他们遭受破坏和创伤。他们需要找代罪者, 身为领袖的大卫自然成为泄愤对象。大卫正心焦如焚, 还要面对部属的攻击, 真是情何以堪! 大卫该什么呢?

1. **“大卫却倚靠耶和华—他的神, 心里坚固。”** (第6节)。在我们的困境中, 我们需要首先寻求神。但即使在我们这样做之前, 我们也必须绝对确定相信谁是神。祂可以而且祂将尽一切的努力使我们摆脱困境。我们如何加强自己? 我们回顾祂过去的忠诚。祂的应许和祂的话语中永恒的爱。祂永远不会离开我们或抛弃我们。我们不仅可亲身经历, 还从别人的见证中看到神的信实。

2. 只有在向神坚固之后, 大卫才**“求问耶和华.....”** (第8节)。可能没有选择, 没有出路, 或者选择太多, 我们真的不知道那些会起作用。我们需要听祂的话。在大卫的情况下, 他的困境是否要或是不要追求, 因为他知道阿马利基特人的战斗力比他的六百名战士大得多。他考虑的可

4. David thought he had at least six hundred men against the huge horde of the Amalekites but two hundred were too exhausted to carry on. The odds against him just increased dramatically but he was very sure of God's promise. He used whatever resources that was available and **"But David pursued, he and four hundred men."** (v10).

Sometimes we fail to act on God's promise because our logical minds tell us that the ingredients for success are simply not there. We need to garner more resources, more help from our friends or our bankers. And we miss the opportunity for God to show His greatness and His faithfulness.

5. As David pursued with just four hundred men he stopped because they came upon a dying man in the desert. He stopped to help a dying man, a stranger of no consequence to what he was doing in pursuing his enemies. Why waste such valuable time? Because David maintained his Christlike character. He helped without expecting anything in return and the Egyptian **"... when he had eaten, his spirit revived, for he had not eaten bread or drunk water for three days and three nights."** (v12).

When we are in desperate situations our survival instincts kick in. We cease caring about others' plight. Our own survival is paramount. In so doing we may end up abandoning our Christian values and principles. We cease to be Christ's salt and light to the world.

6. With the Egyptian's help David was able to locate the Amalekites quickly and launched a surprise attack. He won against huge numerical odds. He won against logical probabilities. **"David recovered all that the Amalekites had taken..."** (v18). **"David brought back all."** (v19).

If we know our God and His faithfulness, we too can recover all that we have lost. Often against all probabilities and logic.

7. But David's recovery was yet not fully complete. Besides recovering all they lost they also captured the spoils and loot that Amalekites took from the other areas they raided. His four hundred men decided that the two hundred who did not fight were not deserving to share in the extras. Why? Because they believed it was their strength, courage and ability that won the battle for them. David rebuked them. He acknowledged God and wanted his men to do the same, **"You shall not do so, my brothers, with what the LORD has given us. He has preserved us and given into our hand the band that came against us."** (v23).

能性很大。他需要上帝的保证，那就是上帝将在战斗中与他同在，并且上帝将兑现祂的应许。

3. 既然他得到了上帝的保证，**"那么大卫出发了....."**（第9节）。他没有拖延。在听到上帝的消息后，他确切知道该怎么做。他抛开了所有的疑虑，而没有受到对他不利的数字的困扰。不担心自己的人想杀死他不会跟随他。他只是按照上帝的保证行事。他的手下跟着。如果我们确信上帝存在于我们的生活中，并且不怀疑上帝的应许，那么我们就不会动摇，如果不确定我们是否正确地听到上帝的意见。我们就是这样做。

4. 大卫认为他至少有600名士兵对抗庞大的阿马利基部队，但有200名工人筋疲力尽，无法继续前进。反对他的几率大大增加了，但他非常确信上帝的应许。他使用了所有可用的资源，**"但大卫追捕，他和四百名士兵。"**（第10节）。

有时候我们无法履行上帝的诺言，因为我们的逻辑思维告诉我们成功的要素根本就不存在。我们需要获得更多资源，更多来自我们朋友或银行家的帮助。我们错过了上帝展示祂的伟大和忠诚的机会。

5. 大卫追赶时只有四百人，他停下来是因为他们遇到了沙漠中一个垂死的人。他停下来帮助一个垂死的男人，这个陌生人对追捕敌人所做的事情没有任何影响。为什么要浪费这么宝贵的时间？因为大卫保持了他基督化的品格。他没有得到任何回报就帮助了埃及人。**".....当这埃及人吃完饭后，精神恢复了，因为他三天三夜没有吃面包或喝水。"**（第12节）。

当我们处于绝望的境况时，我们的生存本能就开始发挥作用。我们不再关心别人的困境。我们只顾自己的生存比较重要。这样做，我们最终可能会放弃我们的基督教价值观和原则。我们不再是世界的盐和光。

6. 在埃及人的帮助下，大卫得以迅速找到阿马利基人，并发动了突袭。他赢得了巨大的数字赔率。他赢了逻辑概率。**"大卫收回了亚玛力基人的一切....."**（第18节）。**"大卫带回了所有人。"**（第19节）。

如果我们了解我们的上帝和祂的忠诚，我们也可以恢复我们拥有的一切丢失的。经常反对所有概率和逻辑。

7. 但是大卫的康复还没有全部完成。除了追回失去的一切外，他们还捕获了阿马利基人突击搜查的其他地区掠夺的战利品和赃物。他的四百人认为，没有战斗的那200人不应该分享这些额外的东西。为什么？因为他们相信是他们的力量，勇气和能力为他们赢得了胜利。大卫斥责了他们。他承认了上帝，并希望他的臣民也照此行事。**"弟兄**

When we have overcome our disasters, we may be tempted to give too much weight to our own abilities and skills to our success. We need to acknowledge that it was all God and none us.

8. David made sure that **“The share of the man who stayed with the supplies is to be the same as that of him who went down to the battle. All will share alike.”** (v24).

We must be mindful to share with those who have been with us but because of their own circumstances could not contribute to our recovery. Not because they did not want to but because they couldn't. We can be happy with our own recovery but what about the others in our community of faith? There are many who are hurting, struggling and unable to even meet basic needs.

9. David acknowledged that his greater than just recovery was from God and therefore the blessing must be shared with the rest of God's community and God be glorified. David sent some of the plunder to the elders of Judah, who were his friends, saying, **“Here is a present for you from the spoil of the enemies of the LORD.”** (v 26)

Our success is dependent on and supported by the various elements that make up our society at large. The infrastructures and institutions, the government and the authorities. The markets, the systems and networks.

10. David remembered the wider society which indirectly contributed to what he was able to achieve. **“David sent it ... to those in all the other places where he and his men had roamed.”** (v 27-31).

Likewise, from our recovery we must extend God's love to all in our society regardless of race or religion.

God's recovery for David was now complete.

当我们克服了灾难后，我们可能会倾向于过于重视自己的能力和技能来取得成功。我们需要承认，这全是上帝，而不是我们。

8. 大卫确保**“陪在补给品上的那个人的份额应与参加战斗的那个人的份额相同。所有人都会共享。”**（第24节）。

我们必须谨记与曾与我们在一起的人分享，但因为他们自己的情况无法促进我们的康复。不是因为他们不想，但因为他们不想。我们可以对自己满意恢复，但是我们信仰社区中的其他人呢？有许多受伤，挣扎甚至无法满足基本需求的人。

9. 大卫承认，他恢复生命的不仅仅是来自上帝，因此，祝福必须与上帝社区的其他人分享，上帝应当得到荣耀。大卫把一些掠夺物交给犹大的长老，他们是他的朋友，说：**“这是耶和华仇敌的祭为你送的礼物。”**（第26节）

我们的成功取决于各种因素，并得到这些因素的支持组成我们的整个社会基础设施和机构政府和当局。市场，系统和网络。

10. 大卫记得更广泛的社会间接地为他的成就做出了贡献。**“大卫把它寄给了.....他和他的手下漫游过的所有其他地方的人。”**（第27-31节）。

同样，从我们的康复中，我们必须将上帝的爱扩展到我们社会中的所有，无论其种族或宗教信仰如何。

上帝对大卫的恢复现已完成。

Opportunities In A Crisis

With the onslaught of the Covid-19 pandemic in Malaysia, the country experienced its first lockdown on 18 March 2020. With that the familiar 'FGB Style' banquets came to a standstill. After a few months I was a bit discouraged as there seemed to be no way to fulfil the six guiding principles of our Mission Statement. Then the thought came that 'HE (Christ) can make a way where there seems to be no way.' I cried to the Holy Spirit for a way to advance His Kingdom.

One night about three in the morning as I was in bed thinking about the problem; the thought came that 'there are opportunities in a crisis.' It was not a problem but an opportunity! I became wide awake and listened intently. The Holy Spirit began to explain what the opportunity was. We could not organise the usual banquets of ten to forty tables where members brought their guests and everyone fellowshiped and listened attentively to testimonies that would stir their hearts to repent their sins and accept the Lord Jesus as their Lord and Saviour. Now the law enables us to have micro-banquets where every 'host' or member has a part to play. My simple question was 'How?' The plan that crystalized was so simple that it needed no explanation. Every member of FGBMFI had been trained to witness. Each had a testimony unique to himself; but many had not taken the opportunity to testify! If you could answer the following questions; you could organise your micro-banquets immediately. The extended lockdown was no longer considered a problem but an opportunity:

Case (1) $2 + 1 = ?$ Case (2) $3 + 2 = ?$

The simple plan was to invite a brother as in Case (1) to join you for lunch or dinner where you invite a guest, a pre-believer. The brother will pray while you share your testimony. At the end of the meal if the guest accepts Christ; you have the answer 3. Should your guest ask if he can bring his wife; then you or your brother can bring his wife also. Both should not bring their wives. Knowing each other well there may be a tendency to gossip. Thus, in Case (2), if the guest accepts Christ (very likely the wife will follow suit); then the answer would be 5.

Remember that even if the guest does not accept Christ, you have sown the seed. You may water, nurture and harvest at a later date. Operating along these lines of modus operandi, micro-banquets will take some of the boredom and tension away during the lockdown period. The micro-banquets will also be at a price that everyone can afford.

Let me share a testimony about an opportunity similar to that of Case (1). I was holidaying with my daughter in New Delhi, India, where the tour guide joined us without invitation for lunch. Initially I was a little annoyed. We were at an upmarket restaurant and tour guides have their own meals with the driver. In my heart I said, "you will get a dose of Jesus Christ for this." While he was chewing the food, I witnessed to him with my personal testimony. At the end of the meal, I asked him if he would like to accept Jesus Christ as his Saviour. To my surprise, he responded with a "Yes". I was curious and asked him why he accepted. His simple answer was, "I am like you once were. I smoke and drink and cannot stop the habit. I want JESUS to help me." He was a Hindu.

By the Grace of God, if you accept the challenge; then there should be many wonderful testimonies of the great things that God has done through you. Let not the pandemic dampened our spirit but to grasp at the golden opportunity presented. We must hasten to explore every avenue possible to activate our FGBMFI Mission Statement and move our market ministry to new levels for the Kingdom of God is at hand.. Hallelujah!

在危机中觅良机



随着新冠肺炎 (Covid-19) 疫情攻击马来西亚，我国于2020年3月18日首度实行动管制令。我们所熟悉的“FGB方式聚餐会”也需要暂停下来。过了几个月后，我对现状有点灰心，按整体局势看来，我们似乎无法完成使命宣言的六大原则。随后，脑海里浮现一个意念：“祂（基督）可以在旷野开道路。”我祈求圣灵指引前进之路，以扩张祂的国度。

有一天，大约凌晨三点钟，我躺在床上反复思想这疫情及管制令的问题，有个意念浮现：“在危机中肯定有良机”。原来这不是艰难而是良机！我顿时清醒过来并专心聆听圣灵开始告诉我当前局势存有有哪些良机。我们无法像平时那样设FGB聚餐会，由10桌至40桌聚餐会，呼吁FGB会员邀请亲戚朋友们前来团契并聆听见证及福音，激励他们认罪悔改，接受主耶稣作为他们个人的救主。如今政府条规只允许小型聚餐，每位“主人家”或会员都要扮演一定的角色。我们的问题很简单：要怎么做呢？逐渐在意念里成形的计划很简单，并不是很复杂。马来西亚全备福音男士团契 (FGBMFI Malaysia) 的每一位会员都曾经受训讲个人见证。每个人的见证都是独一无二；但并不是很多人有机会分享见证！只要你答得出以下问题，就可立刻举办超小型聚餐会了。管制令再怎么延长，也不再是难处而是良机：个案(1) $2+1=?$ 个案(2) $3+2=?$

简单的计划就如个案 (1)，你邀请一位宾客或非信徒时，也请一位FGB弟兄与你一起陪宾客共进午餐或晚餐。当你讲述你的见证时，另一FGB位弟兄就默默祷告。用餐后，如果那位宾客接受基督，你的答案就是3。如果那位宾客询问可否带妻子同来，那么你或你的弟兄也可带妻子一同出席。如果只有俩人出席，我们就不应该同时带着妻子出席，以免你们的妻子俩人，因为太过熟悉而引入自谈悄悄话，冷落了宾客的妻子。那么在个案 (2)，如果嘉宾接受基督（很可能妻子也会跟着这样做）；那么答案就是5。

必须牢记的是，即使宾客没有立刻接受耶稣基督为救主，你已撒下福音种子，你可以继续用神的话语来浇灌及培育他的信心，时候到了再带领他做决志信主，欢呼收割。采用类似方法来运作，超小型聚餐会有助纾缓人心在行管令期间引发的忧闷与紧张情绪、超小型聚餐会的餐费必须是在大家都可以负担的价位上。

让我分享一个类似个案 (1) 的传福音良机。之前，我与女儿在印度新德里度假，导游不请自来与我们共进午餐。开始时我有点不太高兴。我们当时在高档餐馆用餐，导游与巴士司机是有本身的餐饮。我心想：“我应该与他分享一点耶稣的信息作为拌饭。”他在尽情享用饭菜时，我把握时机与他分享我的个人见证。餐后，我问他是否要接受耶稣基督作为他个人救主。令我惊讶的是，他回答说：“要”。我很好奇为什么他会这么爽快接受耶稣。他的答案很简单：“我就像你以前那样：抽烟喝酒，要戒也戒不掉这些坏习惯。我要耶稣帮助我。”他原本是印度教徒。

靠着神的恩典，只要你勇敢地接受挑战，那么你就会有许多奇妙的良机来述说神美好的作为。别让疫情挫败你传福音的志气，要抓紧当前的千载难逢时机。赶紧探索任何可能的管道来实现FGBMFI使命宣言，将职场事工推向更高峰，神的国度就在人间。
