



Hybrids events - it is the future and it is here to stay. With the ongoing Covid-19 endemic, hybrids are getting even more popular. It is now an event that operates in two spaces, the physical and the virtual space.

I strongly predict that even if the endemic ends, hybrids will still be here to stay. This is because it reaches more people in different countries. Business entities will save a lot of money on flights, accommodations, Food & Beverage, and event space.

So how do you succeed at speaking in hybrid events?

Let me share some of my personal experiences as a professional speaker who has spoken in many such events.

1. Greet everyone

Once you are up on the stage, greet everyone who is there. The physical audience that is in front of you and the remote ones.

For those who are in remote locations, you can even acknowledge them in the locations that they are in, "Friends in Malaysia, thank you for coming in!" or "Those who are in joining us remotely, can you type in the country/state that you are in now?"

This creates inclusivity and no one is left behind.

2. Audience engagement is key

If you want to move away from a boring presentation and inject life into it, you need to engage your audience when you are speaking.

Most people attending remotely usually have a shorter attention span because they feel like observers. Once you engage them, they feel part of your audience.

An example of engagement:

"For those who are with us physically, can you please turn to your partner on the left and right and say- we can do this! And those who are joining us remotely, type into the chat "We can do this!"

3. Understand camera locations and stage positioning

This is an important thing that not many speakers are mindful of. A good speaker always takes note of the camera locations. Since you are most likely to be in the event venue, you need to know where you should be standing or moving around so that the cameras can capture you effectively. You don't want a situation where the side cameras do not have a good angle on you.

Most of the time, there will be one main camera that will shoot you from the front. When you talk to your audience, you need to be mindful to speak straight into the camera at times so that the remote audience would feel like you are speaking directly to them as

4. Dress for the cameras

Most stage areas tend to be dark and have bright lights on the speaker. I would highly encourage you not to dress in dark colours or you might fade into the background. Avoid clothing that has lines because they don't appear good on camera.

5. Be energetic

Energy is contagious, even for those who are attending online. Audiences can feel you when you are passionate about something and when you move with energy.

6. Incorporate other remote speakers into your session.

If you are speaking with other presenters who are with you remotely, always acknowledge them and try to bring them into the presentation. You can make references to what they had shared and even have a short dialogue with them during your presentation.

在混合型活动发表演说的技巧

混合型活动,会是未来趋势,且将继续存在。随着 Covid-19疫情持续蔓延,混合型活动蔚然成风。这是实 体与线上同步进行的活动。

我坚决相信,即使疫情结束了,混合型活动仍会继续下去。因为来自不同国家的更多人可参与此类活动。企业单位可节省一大笔用于航班、住宿、餐饮和活动场地等方面的开销。

那么, 要如何在混合型活动好好地发表演说呢?

身为专业演讲者, 我曾多次在这类活动发表演说, 与大家分享一些个人经验谈。

1. 先和大家打个招呼

一旦站在台上,要向在场的每个人问好,包括在你面前的实体观众和远程的线上观众。

对于那些来自远方的人,你甚至可以点名他们所处的地方来表达感谢:"在新加坡的朋友,感谢您们上线参与!"或"那些来自远方的朋友,可以在留言处输入你来自哪个国家/州属吗?"

这样就可以兼顾实体和线上观众,不会忽略了任何人。

2. 与观众互动是关键

如果想摆脱枯燥乏味的演讲,让人耳目一新,就要与观众互动。

大多数参加线上会议的人通常注意力较短,因为他们觉得自己是旁观者。一旦你与他们互动,他们就能够融入其中。

与观众互动的范例:

"在现场的朋友,转向左右的人说:'我们能做到!'。那些线上的朋友,请在留言处输入:'我们能做到!'"

3. 要知道摄像机位置和讲台站位

这点很重要,很少演讲者会留意到这个细节。出色的演讲者会注意摄像机的位置。既然你极可能是在活动现场,需要知道自己应该站在哪里,或在哪个范围内移动,以便摄像机可拍摄到你的最佳姿态。你也不想侧面摄像机无法拍到好的角度。

大多数时候,会有个主摄像机从正面拍摄你。当你与观众交谈时,需要刻意直视镜头,这样线上观众就会觉得你也是直接对他们说话。

4. 穿著要适合上镜

大多数讲台背景会比较阴暗,明亮灯光聚焦在演讲者身上。我劝你最好不要穿深色衣服,否则你可能会融入背景而暗淡无光。避免穿线条衣服,因为镜头前会显得不好看。

5. 展现旺盛活力

活力可以感染人,包括网上参与者。当你对某件事情充满热情,展现出旺盛活力时,观众会受你所感染的。

6. 邀请其他线上演讲者参与会议

如果你与其他远程讲员一起演讲,务必要感谢他们,并 尝试在演讲中提到他们。你可谈及他们的分享,甚至在 你演讲时,与他们有简短对话。

A PENTECOSTAL NIGHT

A Malaysian team that comprised of IRM Evangelical, FGB and Aglo, co-organized Malam Pentakosta 2 (MP2) with Gereja Mawar Sharon (GMS), Surabaya, Indonesia. The event was organized via a zoom platform to allow our audiences to log in to a premier live show of the rally using Gereja Mawar Sharon and Philip Mantofa YouTube channels. Six different channels for six different languages were created to meet the different language needs of the audience. Until December, more than 200 thousand viewers had logged in to the YouTube channels. We believed many viewers had experienced their prayers answered and were filled with the Holy Spirit.

Pastor Philip's sermon on the topic "ROH KUDUS Mencari Seorang SAHABAT" for MP2 was based on Acts 1:1-11. We all need the Holy Spirit in the service of God's Kingdom. Without the Holy Spirit, our witness for Christ will lack deep conviction, self-denying courage, convincing wisdom, and converting effectiveness. As a true friend, the Holy Spirit will empower us to testify with confidence and clothe us with reassuring strength and wisdom. What a friend we have in the Holy Spirit who can transform ordinary people to do extraordinary things like to heal the sick, cast out demons, and set free people from their sins.

Just before Jesus ascended into heaven, He gave His final instructions to his disciples as in Acts 1:8 "But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth." 由IRM福音派、全福会(FGB)和Aglo组成的马来西亚团队,与印尼泗水的沙仑玫瑰教会(Gereja Mawar Sharon,简称"GMS")联手举办五旬节之夜2(Malam Pentakosta 2,简称"MP2")。此活动通过zoom平台举办,让观众通过沙仑玫瑰教会和腓力·曼都法牧师(Philip Mantofa)的YouTube频道观看首播。令人惊讶的是,六个不同频道,满足六个不同语言需求的观众。直到12月,超过20万观众登录此YouTube频道。我们相信许多观众的祷告蒙应允,也经历圣灵充满。

腓力牧师在MP2的证道主题是"圣灵在寻找一位朋友"(ROH KUDUS Mencari Seorang SAHABAT),经文是使徒行传一章1-11节。我们都需要圣灵带领,才有能力服事神的国度。没有圣灵,我们为基督所做的见证将缺乏深刻信念、自我牺牲的勇气、令人信服的智慧和转化的效力。作为真正的朋友,圣灵赋予我们有信心作见证,带着力量和智慧,可安定人心。圣灵是我们的知心好友,祂可转化平凡人的生命,让他们做不平凡的事,比如治病、赶鬼、让人从罪中得自由。

YOU ARE THE SALT OF THE EARTH

SALT CONVENTION

For the first time, the Salters were given the honour to organise a SALT online convention on 16 August 2021. The opportunity came after six years of ministry across the entire of North Borneo. The idea was sparked off by our FGB Sabah Deputy Regional Director, Bro Thomas Tsen. It was held during the second year of the Covid-19 pandemic.

The objective of the event was to encourage and inspire the Salters at a time of crisis. It had been one and a half year since their last Salt activity. They had been disconnected for a long period of time and even within the WhatsApp group itself, they were literally left out in the cold. Covid 19 just added fuel to the fire. A few Salters, who were working after their graduation faced severe challenges when they had to work to support their families in the rural areas. Some of them lost their jobs and that had caused more difficulties. They suffered physically and emotionally. The topic 'Reset, Revive, Arise to Succeed' was an avenue to get connected with the Salters and spark their passion to keep striving with Jesus as their anchor of life.

The planning was carefully mapped out three months before the event. The organisers gathered all the leaders of Salt from across the country through online meetings. They started by finalising the tentative programme and forming three departments; viz. Praise and Worship, Multimedia and Marketing, and Administration. Each of the departments had been assigned to form its own team in order to execute their given tasks. Rehearsals were carried out at least six times before the event since they had to get accustomed to using a new software called OBS Studio with the Zoom application. The preparation was meticulous, from the icebreaking sessions to the closing prayer. Each section of the programme had its own graphics and animations ready to be displayed and all of them were very excited. Some of them slept for only two to three hours just to make sure that the videos were all perfectly rendered out and nothing was missing.

On 16th of August 2021, an hour before the meeting began, there was a blackout in the house of the main person in charge of the programme and multimedia. The group's WhatsApp committee members were in a dilemma, trying to figure out how to overcome the unforeseen occurrence. Some of them were prepared to do the praise and worship live using guitars. Miraculously, the technician was able to back up some of the important videos such as the praise and worship and the Salter's testimony in his pen drive from his computer, just a few seconds before his computer's backup power ran out. The convention started promptly at 7.00 p.m. and went on as scheduled even without the OBS Studio and other graphics. We had congregated one hundred and twenty-two participants and Dato Ir. Janang Bungsu was on fire declaring the Word of God, as the guest speaker during that night.

The programme ran very smoothly despite the hiccups before the event, and everyone enjoyed the night. That was the starting point for Salters to make a comeback after 'hibernating' for one and a half years. A breakthrough had happened and the Salters were eager to meet again to launch other activities. The WhatsApp group began to buzz in a flurry of activity, the nostalgic feeling returned as they looked forward to gather again physically and doing more camps to preach the gospel in every corner of Sabah. Praise the Lord!

SALT大会

学生进阶领导力培训学员(以下简称"Salters")很荣幸于2021年8月16日首次以线上方式举办学生进阶领导力培训(Student Advance Leadership Training,以下简称"SALT")大会。此事工在整个北婆罗洲服事了六年之久,才出现这个机会。这个构思是由FGB沙巴州区域副会长托馬斯 曾弟兄提出,在Covid-19疫情蔓延的第二年举行。

这次活动旨在危机时刻召集Salters,以鼓励并激励大家。距离上次大会已有一年半了,彼此已有很长一段时间没有联系,甚至在WhatsApp群里,大家也渐行渐远了。Covid 19疫情令彼此关系更趋生疏。有一些Salters毕业后要打工赚钱,以寄钱给乡下的家人,生活过得很不容易。有一些则保不住工作而陷入更大困境。他们身心疲惫不堪。大会的主题是"重置、复苏、兴起发光"(Reset, Revive, Arise to Succeed) 要与Salters取得连结,激发热情,鼓励他们以耶稣为生命中心并继续奔跑前路。

主办方花了三个月时间用心筹备这项活动,通过线上会议召集全国各地的大会领袖。他们先拟出暂定节目表,并成立三个部门,即赞美与敬拜部、多媒体与营销部,以及行政部。每个部门都受指派组织各自的团队以执行任务。在活动前至少进行了六次排练,因为他们必须掌握OBS Studio新软件和Zoom应用程序。从破冰游戏到结束祷告,都准备得一丝不苟。节目的每个环节都准备了各自的图表和动画来展示,所有人都非常兴奋,有些人只睡了两到三个小时,只为了确保能完美呈现视频,没有任何疏漏。

会议于2021年8月16日开始前一个小时,负责节目和多媒体的主要负责人家里突然停电。该小组的WhatsApp委员会成员陷入进退两难困境,试图想办法应对突发状况。有人准备用吉他进行现场赞美和敬拜。神奇的是,技术人员在电脑备用电源耗尽

的前几秒,及时备份了一些重要视频,如赞美和敬拜以及Salter的见证。大会得以在晚上7点准时开始,即使没有OBS Studio和其他图表,大会也如期进行。我们聚集了一百二十二名参与者,拿督Ir. Dato Ir. Janang Bungsu为当晚的特邀讲员,火力全开地宣讲了神的话语。

尽管活动前有段小插曲,但节目进行得非常顺利, 大家都乐在其中。这是Salters"冬眠"一年半后卷土 重来的起点。突破已经发生,Salters渴望再次聚 会,开展其他活动。WhatsApp群组开始热闹起 来,唤醒了昔日情怀,大家期待再次相聚,在沙巴 各个角落举办更多营会,传扬福音。赞美主!

SCHOOL OF VISION FGBMFI 异象学校

School of Vision FGBMFI (SOV) was the brainchild of John Carrette from Texas, USA. He was appointed by the president, Mario Garcia, to start and train Full Gospel Business Men's Fellowship International (FGBMFI) leaders from various nations regarding the vision of FGBMFI and how it all started through Demos Shakarian. So far, the SOV had launched its training programme in Ukraine, Africa, Europe, and the USA.

John joined FGBMFI in 1978 as the founding treasurer of the first chapter in Guatemala. He had served as international director under Demos Shakarian, Richard Shakarian, and Mario Garcia.

The Syllabus of the SOV:

The syllabus was tailored upon the books written by Demos Shakarian and all participants must read the following books:

- Happiest People on Earth
- The Visión Intensified
- The Ultimate Dimension
- A New Wave of Revival in Your Finances
- Behold The Glory of God
- Divine Life
- Come let us Exalt Him
- The Greatest Business in the world
- Tommy Hicks Dream

All the books plus your personal Bible contained the REVELATIONS that God showed Demos Shakarian. God's CALLING and ASSIGNMENT of Demos as a Helper in the body of Christ made FGBMFI the perfect place for a man or woman to discover their calling from God and begin to walk in it. The Class Structure:

There are 12 classes of 1.5 hours per class for the course participants. The last class is mainly a graduation ceremony with an invited speaker. Diplomas are awarded by the world FGBMFI. After graduation, there are five classes for leaders of chapters and leaders of nations that teach leaders how to inculcate the vision in their members. By the end of the training course, members will be conscious of Christ in them and leaders will be able to help members cooperate with Jesus so as to allow Him to express His love and power through them. Our FGBMFI Malaysia committee consists of Lim Lian Hong, Chee Yon Long, Yesudas, Raymond Tay, and Council member Wong Hong Meng as the adviser.

AIRLIFTS TO FGB NATIONS

The airlift project was a FGBMFI Malaysia led initiative to reach out to FGB Nations.

Main Objectives:

- A) To enhance networking opportunities among FGB Nations.
- B) To introduce and expose next generation leaders onto the international platform.
- C) To pray for each Nation.

In 2021, when most Asia Pacific Nations were challenged with the COVID 19 Lockdowns, FGB Malaysia was able to reach out to six (6) of the following nations via the Virtual Airlift, a meeting through Zoom in Cyberspace:

- 1. FGB Australia
- 2. FGB Hong Kong
- 3. FGBMFI Philippines
- 4. FGBMFI Indonesia
- 5. FGBMFI Japan
- 6. FGBMFI Vietnam

Members of participating nations were excited over the Airlift opportunity to connect and re-connect with one another.

Each of the Airlift was scheduled between 75 to 90 minutes.

Interpretation was provided for by the relevant participating nation.

For effective interaction, participation was limited to 15 members per nation.

Efforts are ongoing to invite more FGB Nations to join the Airlift programme.

The current programme to FGB Nations could be further expanded from Bi-Lateral to Multi-Lateral Nations in the future, as and when the needs and opportunities arose.

Waybox Project

June 2021 Waybox Report

As you are aware, the Waybox Project was initiated last year assisting needy families and destitutes arising from the MCO and the subsequent months. Through the sponsorship of grocery boxes from the Bountiful Eye Foundation, Kuok Group and many cash donors, we managed to help more than 2,500 families.

Since November 2020, we resort to targeted approach. Under this method, we identify about 400 families in JB and Segamat and provide them with the boxes on a monthly basis. These families are selected based on recommendations and after a prequalifying process to ensure proper accountability.

We work mainly with our Full Gospel Business Men's Fellowship in JB and Segamat as well as the local churches.

Prior to the school re-opening this year, we launched the Back to School (BTS) program, providing school uniforms and accessories to more than 100 students.

We have also on various occasions provided milk powder to children aged less than 5 years.

The current FMCO has compounded the needs. We are still distributing the boxes but with more precautions taken to comply with the SOPs.

Due to the needs of some charitable homes, we provide packed food to them once a week.

With all these activities, obviously our fund is running low. For the second time since its initiation last year, we wrote to those who are keen to contribute to contact us.





IRM Food Basket Report

- Miri, Sibu, Kuching, Bintulu, Mukah and Kapit are currently categorised as Red Zone Areas, while Betong as Orange Zone Area and Yellow Zone Areas are Kota Samarahan, Sri Aman, Limbang, Serian and Sarikei. (updated: 5 February 2021 Sarawak Disaster Management Committee)
- These affected areas are also our IRM evangelism areas. IRM evangelists have been reporting the hardships faced by the villagers especially now as they are not able to plant, harvest or sell paddy or farm produces to town. Those working in towns are also affected since most of them are paid daily wages
- Free Malaysia Today press statement dated 3rd February by Sarawak Dayak National Union (SDNU) Sibu branch Chairman, Chambai Lindong stated that those mainly affected are from rural areas working as general labourers, cooks and helpers at coffee shops, restaurants and bistros, helpers at hair salons, electricians and welders, lorry drivers and attendants, shop assistants, security guards and cleaners. Not less than 1000 people in Sibu Division are desperately need food aid due to job and/or income loss following the closure of their work sectors since the enforcement of the MCO, January 16.
- Along with this, we believe those living in the village are also affected and do not know where or how to get help from. Our response to help the needy at these unprecendented difficult would be the answer to their prayer and plea.
